ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL MEETING

AD COUNCIL MEETING

Ad Council met on March 3rd. Pastor has been working on pre-martial classes. She hopes to visit members when she is feeling better. Relay for Life's bake sales will be April 6, 20, and May 4 at Berkot Super Foods. The Blanket Bee will meet on the

third Wednesday of the month one time during the daytime and one month in the evening and will take the summer off. They will start fundraising for Royal Family Kids (RFK). Shalom Center picked up the Shalom to Home Kits (3 bath and 2 cleaning). We need to replace a carbon monoxide detector. We also need to replace the outdoor floodlight. We need to find someone with a lift to replace the lightbulb on the post in the parking lot. We discussed Communion, we still need someone or a group to get the communion ready each month. We decided to go back to doing communion by intinction. (We will review this in April.) Wilmot UMC will be hosting the Good Friday service. The March Community Senior Fellowship will be on the Sharing Center. The March Game night had 11 people attend. We will be filing a Property Exemption report with the Village of Salem Lakes.

We discussed our church's website. We gave approval to switch the hosting and design but still need approval from Ad Council before it goes into affect on April 2nd. We reviewed the January and February treasurer's reports. Living Waters will be collecting items for the Textile drive during the year and stored at Bristol's parsonage. We discussed how to revitalized Wilmot UMC and decided on a book study on the second and fourth Sunday starting April 14 after worship for a hour. The book is "10 Prescriptions for a Healthy Church" by Bob Farr and Kay Kotan and everyone is responsible for their own book. Our next meeting will be Sunday, April 7th at 10:00 AM.
