
## GAME NIGHT Friday, March 1st 6:30 pm

# AD COUNCIL MEETING

Ad Council met on January 28th. Pastor is doing a pre-marriage class for someone getting married in June. We need to have conversations about how we see our

future. The Blanket Bee will meet on the third Wednesday of the month. We are collecting items for Operation Christmas Child. Relay for Life will have three bakes on April 6th and 20th and May 4th at Berkot Store. Rachel Hewitt and Michelle Walter will be doing the Royal Family Kids Camp from June 16th— 21st and will be asking for donations soon. We made a profit of \$2,263 on the Holiday Cookie Fundraiser. The Staff Parish Relations Committee (SPRC) met with the District Superintendent to discuss pastoral appointments. The Vital Merger has been put on hold since the finances are not there and Pleasant Prairie UMC only have 4 members and will be assessing their future.

We discussed Holy Season. The Ash Wednesday Service will be at Salem UMC on February 14th at 7:00 pm. Wilmot UMC will host the Good Friday Service on March 29th at 7:00 pm. Every church will have their own Easter Service instead of a joint service. We will have Joint Worship on the fifth Sunday in June and September. The February Senior Ministry will be a storyteller.

Our 2024 budget changed to \$63,387 since we had to increase the FICA since Pastor isn't allowed to use Housing Allowance. We will add mission projects to our online giving. We discuss updating the computer website and want to check on what it takes to switch it over. We reviewed the December treasurer's report. Living Waters has tabled the youth program since most of the youth are in college. They will have the textile drive in the fall but are collecting during the year. We will have two game nights. The dates are Friday, March 1st and April 12th at 6:30 pm. Our next meeting will be Sunday, March 3th at 10:00 AM.
