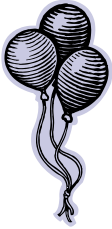

AD COUNCIL MEETING

Ad Council met on May 23d. Pastor Steve had us read and sign "A Covenant of Leadership". A motion was approved for \$10,000 of the Pastor's yearly salary be used as Housing Allowance (since he started in May the amount for Housing Allowance will be \$6,000.). The sanctuary sound system isn't working, so we will have someone check it out. The belfry has been cleaned and the work is done where the raccoon got in. Church Mutual wants us to decide if we want UMC or standard program endorsement on our policy. We decided to stay with the standard and will increase our deductible to \$1,000. We discussed Holy Communion and will use the prepackage juice but cut the bread into small piece for people to take. We will add the "Shalom" back after the Benediction. We will continue wearing masks for the time being since we just started singing on May 23rd and review in a couple weeks. We are thinking of starting Community Senior Fellowship in the fall. We approved the March and April treasurer's reports and filed for future audit. Living Waters sent \$1,000 to India for Covid relief. There are many kits going out for Shalom to Home. Our next meeting will be Sunday, July 25th at 1:30 PM.
